Glen LeBlanc is currently Senior Vice President Finance, Bell Canada and will assume the role of Executive Vice President & Chief Financial Officer of BCE & Bell Canada in July 2015.

Previously, Glen was Executive Vice President & Chief Financial Officer of Bell Aliant Inc. since July 2006. He was responsible for overseeing all aspects of financial management within Bell Aliant's operations.

Mr. LeBlanc also served as Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer for Aliant – Bell Aliant's predecessor company - since September 2005. Glen joined Aliant in 1993, holding a number of senior management positions with increasing levels of responsibility.

Mr. LeBlanc is Vice – Chair of the Board of Directors of Certified Management Accountants of Nova Scotia and played an active role (locally and nationally) in the merger and unification of the Accountants Profession in Canada. He also chairs the Creating Champions campaign for Cape Breton University. He previously sat on the Boards of the Greater Halifax Partnership, Atlantic Provinces Economic Council, Cape Breton University and Feed Nova Scotia.

In 2005, Mr. LeBlanc was named one of Canada's Top 40 Under 40[™] based on his achievements in the areas of vision and leadership; innovation and achievement; impact; community involvement and contribution; and contribution to Aliant's growth strategy.
